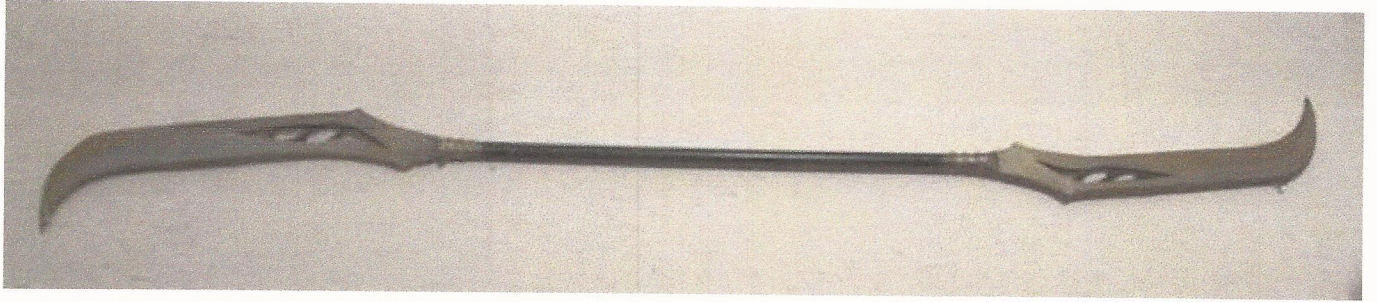



The Mirkwood Double Bladed Polearm





MIRKWOOD DOUBLE BLADED POLEARM

- PRINT TEMPLATE ON CARD STOCK (OR GLUE ONTO CEREAL BOARD)

- START WITH PARTS FOR CARDBOARD CUT OUT & TAPE TOGETHER ON DOTTED LINES.  TRACE ONTO CARDBOARD

TWICE & CUT OUT. THIS IS THE CENTER PIECE FOR EACH BLADE.

- FOAM BOARD PIECES. CUT OUT & TAPE TOGETHER  TAPE TOGETHER 1ST THEN USE AN EXACTO TO CUT OUT THE MIDDLE PIECE. TRACE ONTO FOAM BOARD 4 TIMES. THESE ARE YOUR OUTER PARTS.

- FOR EACH BLADE & ON EITHER SIDE OF CENTER PIECE MATCH UP THE UPPER PORTION OF THE BASE OF THE BLADE & CENTER THE REMAINDER SO SOME CARDBOARD HANGS OUT ON TOP & BOTTOM  GLUE INTO PLACE.

- USING HOT GLUE FILL IN THE SPACE & TAPER IT WITH SCRAPS OF CARDBOARD

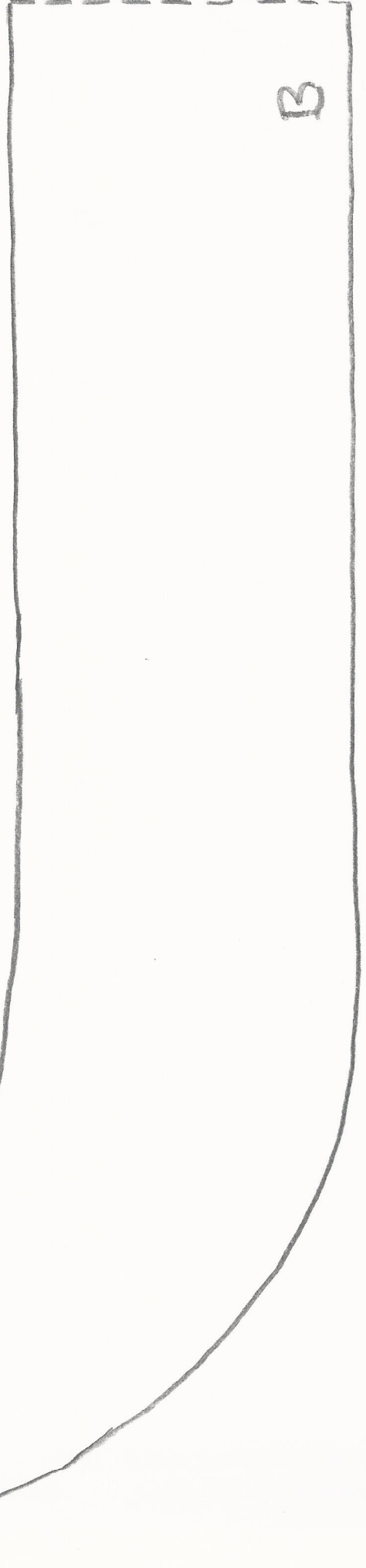
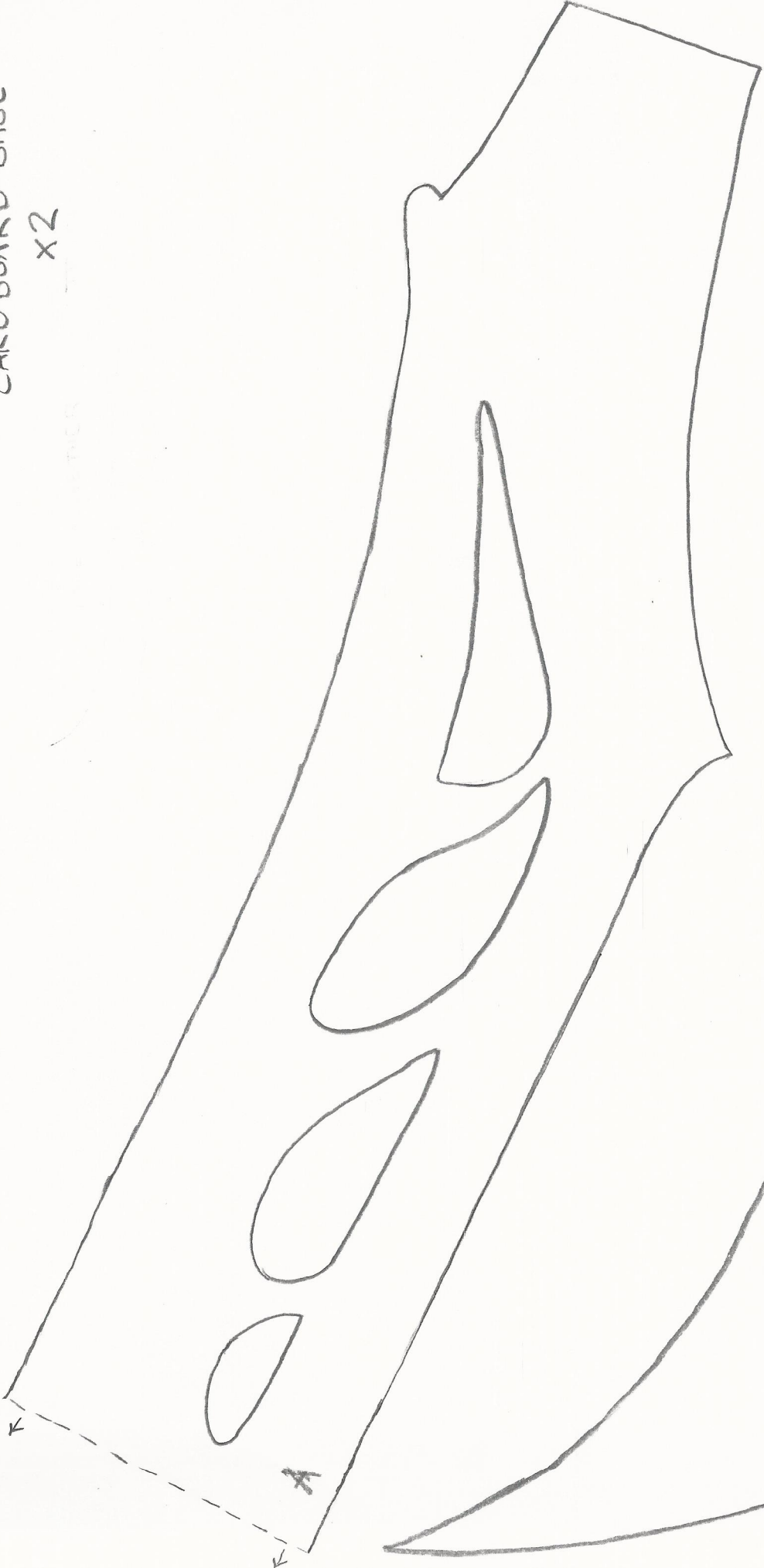


ALTERNATE - IF YOU DON'T CARE FOR THE TAPERED EDGES SIMPLY USE THE CARDBOARD TEMPLATE ON THE FOAM BOARD BUT DO NOT TRACE THE INNER PIECES. INSTEAD ONCE THE OUTER BLADE IS TRACED USE THE FOAM BOARD TEMPLATE & MATCH IT UP AS DIAGRAM ABOVE SHOWS & TRACE THE INNER PARTS.
